**BACKGROUND**: In accordance with the Amherst Youth Town Council Policy, there is an ability to accept up to 15 members. Currently there are 8 students on AYTC.

**<u>DISCUSSION</u>**: Involving youth in the community adds value to youth development; it empowers our young people to be active participants in their community through positive engagement. The Amherst Youth Town Council also provides Council with a youth perspective on issues pertaining to the youth in Amherst.
