

SYNOPSIS

Provincial Courthouse Accessibility Ramp

The Province of Nova Scotia intends to alter the Provincial Courthouse building to make it barrier-free. This will include the installation of an exterior accessibility ramp on the north side entrance facing Victoria Square, and installation of an elevator within the existing building footprint.

As a designated heritage property, the exterior ramp constitutes a substantial alteration, which under the NS Heritage Act requires review by the Heritage Advisory Committee

MOTION:

That Council approve the addition of an accessibility ramp as proposed, and as recommended by the Heritage Advisory Committee.
