Demographic and Business Support

The Business Development Officer completed research and preparation of an economic development dashboard and community economic analysis for Amherst. These documents will be valuable to measure different aspects of economic health while identifying areas that would benefit from initiatives and strategic interventions.

The dashboard includes 16 economic indicators under four categories: business outlook, population, housing and labour force. The economic dashboard will be updated regularly to track trends and measure the effectiveness of interventions.

The community economic analysis provides deeper insights to the economic indicators and a comparative analysis of Amherst in relation to other communities, the province, and Canada.

Respond to Business Investment Opportunities

Two inquiries related to the industrial park were received and the Business Development Officer is working with both site selectors to encourage them to choose Amherst.

Support Initiatives at the Community Credit Union Business Innovation Centre.

A total of 209 hours of bookings were seen during May, an increase of more than 33 hours compared to May 2018. Bookings included business training workshops provided by the Town of Amherst, a fundraiser event for the LA Animal Shelter, a community theatre performance, economic development meetings and high school tutoring in the Hub networking space. The conference room, boardroom and hub meeting room were used by businesses, community groups, and government organizations.

Increase the Impact of Tourism on the Local Economy

- Completed design of a local and regional map and activity guide for distribution to visitor information centres and tourism operators.
- Met with economic development partners to explore how the new Canadian Experiences Fund could be used for projects supporting tourism in Amherst and region.
- Updated the shopping guide and dining guide.
