Monthly Report

Planning & Strategic Initiatives June-2019

Staff continue to further develop Council's Strategic Priority Outcome Areas. With the Vision, Mission, Guiding Principles, and Strategic Priority Areas generally agreed upon, Council was presented with a way to measure progress on addressing the Priority Areas, and asked to consider some larger multi-year initiatives with significant budget implications.

The NSPI Smart Grid Implementation Project is ongoing with the second funding announcement held in Shediac on May 12th. With the Solar for Community Buildings program awarded for the Stadium, and the project approved by Council in May, staff are working on getting a structural assessment Stadium Roof. Staff are also making preparations for another bidding round under the Solar for Community Buildings program that is expected to come out in the coming months.

With Council having given 1st reading to amend the PACE Bylaw, consideration for second reading will be on Council's agenda at its June regular meeting. Staff have communicated the need for amendments to the Cumberland Energy Authority, and the program Administrator, Clean Foundation.

Planning also continues to provide planning and development services for the Town of Oxford.
